TREK ENTRIES:

Trek 2023 entries have been slow to come in. There are only 94 more sleeps before we meet at the Murchison Tavern in Geraldton on Tuesday 30th May, and over the next week I need to commit final numbers to the various venues, caterers, fuel providers, etc. along the Trek route. Many venues require a critical mass to be able to provide services cost-effectively (or at all) so if you are going to enter, but have not yet done so, *please download your Entry Form and return it to the Trek office this week*.

We will be letting people & towns know what our requirements are next week.

BROOME IS TREK AUCTION NIGHT:

Broome is an ideal town for our mid-point town, allowing crews to change over, partners to fly in for a catch up, etc. It is also the perfect location for our **Auction Night**, which will be held on Monday night 5th June. If you are conducting crew changes, please make sure they are in Broome for the Auction Night – auctions are a huge source of funds for The Doctor, and we don't want the RFDS to miss out.

THE ROADS IN THE KIMBERLEY:

The roads in the Kimberley are receiving a large amount of attention from State & Federal Governments. Getting the roads open is a national priority.

The Broome-Derby Road (the Great Northern Highway) has been open during daylight hours for a couple of weeks now, with nightworks continuing to get the road back in shape for the coming tourist season.

The Gibb River Road is still closed to through traffic, with local traffic access only in some areas. There is still flooding in a couple of spots and WA Roads haven't been able to get crews working yet, however I am assured that this is "pretty normal" for February/March.

These roads are vital supply lines to the Kimberley & NT communities that they service, and masses of resources are being marshalled to get them back into shape as soon as possible. My spies assure me that all will be well with the Gibb by early or mid-May, barring any more unforeseen weather events.

Broome to Perth::

I have located a Broome based carrier who will be able to help at a price of \$1,150 per vehicle, transporting the cars back to Perth on a flat top truck. If you are considering this as an option to let me know ASAP so I can let the carrier know volume of cars requiring transport, and I will put you in touch.

VHF RADIOS:

We noticed last year that Trekkers who are running older style 40 channel UHF radios are having trouble hearing, and being heard, by those people who have 80 channel systems. Our boffins have confirmed to us that this problem will only get worse, and in the short future the 40 channel UHF's will start to be unable to receive signals from the 80 channel systems. 80 Channel systems have been around for over 10 years, so it might be time to upgrade if you haven't already done so.
