TREK ENTRIES:

You are able to enter your car now, however I am still working with several venues and local authorities regarding disbursements fees, and it might be a few weeks until Trek 2024 can be properly costed. COVID has left many residual issues that need to be overcome. The information regarding entry payments is on the last page. As soon as the budget for disbursements is finalised, I will create the entry forms and advise everybody on the mail list, by both text & email.

N.B.: Due to capacity constraints at some of the overnight locations, Trek 2024 will be limited to 220 people.

TREK TOWNS & ROADS:

Trek 2024 towns will include a mix of old favourites and some new places. The Trek will stop at several tiny towns/locations, several mid-sized towns, and our second-last night will be in the city of Toowoomba.

The mid-sized towns and Toowoomba should provide many accommodation options for you and in two of the tiny locations we have booked out all of the rooms. I will ballot out these rooms to entries received by January 12th.

Most of the roads will be new to the Trek, and this may very well be your last opportunity to travel the Strzelecki Track before it is bituminised.

ACCOMMODATION:

The event is named *"The Outback Car Trek"* for good reason - it is an event that is designed to take people off the beaten track and away from the cities and large towns. Therefore, it stands to reason that bright lights and crisp white sheets are few and far between.

At Arkaroola and Innamincka both locations have accommodation. But there are not enough rooms for everyone on the Trek. However they do have great camping facilities, and meals to die for. To make things equitable for all participants, the Trek has booked all of the available accommodation in these two places. Approximately 10 rooms in each place will be put up for Auction to the highest bidder in April, with all profits going to the RFDS.

The remaining rooms will be subject to a ballot amongst cars who have entered by no later than January 12th. The ballot will be held on Saturday January 20th 2024.

Wanaaring has zero accommodation available, but a great rodeo ground with good facilities for our use.

Please don't ring any of these locations demanding rooms – I am receiving negative feedback from the venues, and it is affecting the Trek's (and the RFDS) reputation.

When booking accommodation in the other towns, I suggest you refer to the trek route page on the website and book somewhere close to the dinner venues. In Mildura and Toowoomba buses will be put on to help people get to and from the dinner.

To be clear: to go into the ballot for rooms in Arkaroola and Innamincka your car must be entered into the 2024 Outback Car Trek by no later than Friday January 12th 2024.
