TREK 2024 SECOND SURVEY COMPLETED

We have just arrived home after a very successful second survey of the 2024 Trek route, bedding in catering, venues, fuel, etc. for the event. The significance of starting in Bendigo is that we will be able to visit the birthplace of John Flynn at Moliagul, shortly after we leave town.

The drives through Mildura to Burra, and then the Flinders Ranges and the Strzelecki Track, will be amazing. As will the drive west to east into NSW and Queensland, and then across to Sea World on the Gold Coast.

It will not be long before the Strzelecki is fully sealed; 2024 might be your last chance to drive the Track before it becomes a bitumen highway.



ENTRIES ARE ROLLING IN, AND NUMBERS ARE LIMITED

As you will be aware, we have a cap of 220 people on Trek 2024, which is why we have been keen to suggest to you to get your entries in as soon as possible. We currently have 85 cars registered for the event, and I expect to be fully subscribed by the middle of January.
