### 2023 Outback Car Trek Entry Form

Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> May to Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> June Geraldton to Darwin

The 2023 annual Outback Car Trek, raising funds for the Royal Flying Doctor Service, will be conducted over 12 days. The Trek will leave, after a participant's briefing, from Geraldton in WA on Wednesday morning May 31<sup>st</sup> and will arrive into Darwin NT on Sunday afternoon June 11<sup>th</sup>.

Participation in the Outback Car Trek is a reward for raising \$7,500 per vehicle (or more) for the Royal Flying Doctor Service of Australia and is an event for older model 2WD vehicles (Trek Cars) that comply with the published Supplementary Regulations, as amended from time to time. Also, a limited number of late model 4WD vehicles are accepted into the event as "Support Vehicles" (Supports).

There has been a change to the car eligibility criteria since 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021.
 From that date 2WD motor cars more than 30 years old (plus identical model run-ons) will be considered for entry into the Trek, as long as they comply with the Trek Supplementary Rules & Regulations.

Entries must be made using the following form, and will be processed on a first come, first served basis. All entries are subject to acceptance by the event organiser, and the event organiser reserves the right to refuse entry for any reason.

There are three separate types of payments required to participate in the Trek:

- 1. Donation
- 2. Entry Fee
- 3. Disbursements Fee

#### Details of each of these fees:

- A donation of \$7,500 (or more) per vehicle. Payable to the Royal Flying Doctor Service.
  - a. The donation is not subject to GST.
- 2. The Entry Fee \$1,050 (per vehicle). Payable to the Royal Flying Doctor Service South Eastern Section. **N.B.** The Entry Fee is payable in full whether you participate in only part of, or in the entire, Trek.
  - a. The Entry Fee includes GST.





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- 3. The Disbursements Fee. This fee is per person, and is payable to Outback Car Trek Pty Ltd. There are three different participation options for Trek 2023:
  - a. Geraldton to Broome 8 days, this is "Part A" of the Trek, and this Disbursements Fee is \$930 per person
  - b. Broome to Darwin 7 days, this is "Part B" of the Trek, and the Disbursements Fee is \$1,370 per person
  - c. Geraldton to Darwin 12 days, the entire Trek, the Disbursements Fee is \$1,950 per person

The Disbursements Fee includes GST.

N.B. The Trek Auction night will be held on the evening we arrive in Broome – Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023. If you are flying in for "Part B" of the Trek, please make every effort to be in Broome in time to attend the Auction.

Both the Entry Fee and the Disbursements Fee are calculated on a cost recovery basis. The Disbursements Fee covers a multitude of costs, including all meals on that section of the event you enter, with the exception of Saturday 6th June. Saturday is a "lay day" and no meals or activities have been planned for participants. The Disbursements Fee also covers a variety of other items such as various Council hire fees, the hire of catering venues & equipment, audio visual hire fees, entertainment, public liability insurance, the cost of your movie and photo DVDs, coach transfers, some camping fees, National Parks fees, your road books and a great many other expenses.

Guests are welcome to attend the Auction Night and dinner in Broome on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June, and also the Gala Dinner in Darwin on the final night of the Trek, Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> June. The charge for guests for these events is detailed in the entry form and is set at cost price.

#### Support Cars.

Support vehicles are also accepted into the event on the proviso that these vehicles will readily and willingly provide whatever assistance may be required, to any vehicle participating in the Trek which requires help of any kind. Whilst Supports may sometimes join a team, it is important to note that a Support vehicle is not there to support *only* that team. Support vehicles are not just luggage carriers, they are required to support each and every car in the Trek, regardless of whether the occupants are known to them or not.

Each entry, be it Trek car or Support, is required to abide by the Trek Code of Conduct, and submission of your entry is an acceptance by the team captain and crew that you have read, and agree to adhere to, that Code of Conduct, as amended.





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#### Donations.

For ease of management, the RFDS South Eastern Section administers the donations made to the Flying Doctor Outback Car Trek, however the donations are channelled back to your home operating section. For example, if you enter a car from Toowoomba, your donations are sent to Queensland Section, if you enter from Kalgoorlie your donations are channeled back to Western Operations, and so on.

The Royal Flying Doctor Service have set up an umbrella web page for fundraising, and you are able to open your own page and circulate the page amongst your contacts. This is a great way to increase the amount of funds you raise.

<u>Friday 2nd June</u> - Denham to Carnarvon

<u>Saturday 3rd June</u> - Carnarvon to Onslow

Sunday 4th June - Onslow to Port Hedland

N.B. in Port Hedland we have arranged single accommodation for 250 people in a modern mining village in the township - dinner, bed and breakfast will be here, but feel free to make your own arrangements if you prefer, simply let me know on your entry form. These beds will be allocated on a first come basis. Please note this accommodation is a single bed ensuite room.

**Wednesday 7th June** - Broome to Mt Elizabeth Station

Saturday 10th June - Top Springs to Katherine

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### FLYING DOCTOR OUTBACK CAR TREK ENTRY FORM

I wish to lodge my entry for the 2023 Outback Trek as per the attached pages.

The 2023 Outback Car Trek will be made up of two parts. You can take part in the entire Trek from Geraldton to Darwin, or you can take part in either of Part A or Part B. Part A is Geraldton to Broome and Part B is Broome to Darwin.

Included with my entry form is either a credit card authorisation form, or notification of direct deposit for my Entry Fee of \$1,050 per vehicle, made payable to the Royal Flying Doctor Service South-Eastern Section, and the Disbursements Fee of:

- The Disbursements Fee for the entire Trek is \$\$1,950 per participant, made payable to Outback Car Trek Pty Limited
- The Disbursements Fee for Part A only of the Trek is \$ 930 and per participant, made payable to Outback Car Trek Pty Limited
- The Disbursements Fee for Part B only is \$ 1,370 per participant, made payable to Outback Car Trek Pty Limited

This year in Port Hedland the Trek has arranged single accommodation for 250 people, plus dinner, breakfast and lunch, to be made available to participants in a mining village in the township. The dinner bed & breakfast package is available on a first come first served basis, and you are required to enter your preference with your payment on the credit card page of the Entry Form. If you wish to make your own arrangements in Port Hedland, that is perfectly acceptable, simply make that notation on the form. These beds will be allocated on a first come basis.

I understand that my entry fee is neither refundable nor transferable (unless my entry is not accepted) for any reason and my disbursements fee is non-refundable unless 30 days cancellation notice is given.

I agree that my car will donate a minimum of \$7,500 per vehicle to the Royal Flying Doctor Service.





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I have read and understood both the 2023 Supplementary Regulations, and the Trek Code of Conduct and agree to abide by them.

Each crew member of our car is aware that filming will take place on the event, and they authorise any images taken to be placed on various social media platforms at the discretion of the event organiser.

Also included with this entry form is a signed indemnity form from each crew member of our car, and a completed medical conditions form for each person.

I understand that entries in the event are strictly limited and that I will be advised in due course whether or not my entry has been accepted. All entries are subject to acceptance by the event organiser, and the event organiser reserves the right to refuse entry for any reason.
