2024 Outback Car Trek Entry Form Sunday 2nd June to Sunday 9th June Bendigo to Sea World Gold Coast

The 2024 annual Outback Car Trek, raising funds for the Royal Flying Doctor Service, will be **conducted over 8 days**. The Trek will leave, after a participant's briefing, from Bendigo in Victoria on Sunday morning June 2nd and will arrive into the Sea World Resort on the Gold Coast of Queensland on Sunday June 9th.

Due to capacity restraints in some locations our 2024 numbers will be limited to 220 people. Acceptance into the 2024 Trek will be at the absolute and sole discretion of the Trek Director.

Participation in the Outback Car Trek is a reward for raising \$7,500 per vehicle (or more) for the Royal Flying Doctor Service of Australia and is an event for older model 2WD vehicles (Trek Cars) that comply with the published Supplementary Regulations, as amended from time to time. Also, a limited number of late model 4WD vehicles are accepted into the event as "Support Vehicles" (Supports).

• There have been changes to the car eligibility criteria in recent times. Currently 2WD motor cars more than 30 years old (plus identical model runons) will be considered for entry into the Trek, as long as they comply with the Trek Supplementary Rules & Regulations.

Entries must be made using the following form, and all entries are subject to acceptance by the event organizer. The event organiser reserves the right to refuse entry for any reason.

There are three separate types of payments required to participate in the Trek:

- 1. Donation
- 2. Entry Fee
- 3. Disbursements Fee

Details of each of these fees:

- 1. A donation of \$7,500 (or more) per vehicle. Payable to the Royal Flying Doctor Service.
 - a. The donation is not subject to GST.









- 2. The Entry Fee \$1,050 (per vehicle). Payable to the Royal Flying Doctor Service South-Eastern Section.
 - a. The Entry Fee includes GST.
 - *b.* The Entry Fee is non-refundable, unless your entry is not accepted for any reason.
- 3. The Disbursements Fee of \$1,350 for the eight nights. This fee is per person, and is payable to Outback Car Trek Pty Ltd:
 - a. The Disbursements Fee includes GST
 - b. The Disbursements Fee is non-refundable unless your entry is refused for any reason, or less than 45 days prior to the Trek commencement date.

Both the Entry Fee and the Disbursements Fee are calculated on a cost recovery basis. The Disbursements Fee covers a multitude of costs, including all meals. The Disbursements Fee also covers a variety of other items such as various Council hire fees, the hire of catering venues & equipment, audio visual hire fees, entertainment, public liability insurance, the cost of any photography, coach transfers, some camping fees, National Parks fees, your road books and a great many other expenses.

Guests are welcome to attend the lunch on our arrival into the Gold Coast, and also the Gala Dinner at Sea World on the final night of the Trek, Sunday 9th June. The charge for guests for these events is detailed in the entry form and is set at cost price.

Support Cars.

Support vehicles are also accepted into the event on the proviso that these vehicles will readily and willingly provide whatever assistance may be required, to any vehicle participating in the Trek which requires help of any kind. Whilst supports may sometimes join a team, it is important to note that a Support vehicle is not there to support *only* that team. Support vehicles are not just luggage carriers, they are required to support each and every car in the Trek, regardless of whether the occupants are known to them or not.

Each entry, be it Trek car or Support, is required to abide by the Trek Code of Conduct, and submission of your entry is an acceptance by the team captain and crew that you have read, and agree to adhere to, that Code of Conduct, as amended.

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Donations.

For ease of management, the RFDS South-Eastern Section administers the donations made to the Flying Doctor Outback Car Trek, however the donations are channeled back to your home operating section. For example, if you enter a car from Toowoomba, your donations are sent to Queensland Section, if you enter from Kalgoorlie your donations are channeled back to Western Operations, and so on.

The Royal Flying Doctor Service will set up an umbrella web page for fundraising, and you are able to easily create your own page and circulate the page amongst your contacts. This is a great way to increase the amount of funds you raise.

TREK 2023 – WE ARE GOING WHERE ??

The route may change at any time at the discretion of the event organiser. Due to capacity constraints in some locations, our 2024 numbers will be limited to 220 people. Acceptance into the Trek will be at the absolute and sole discretion of the Trek Director.

Saturday 1st June 2024: Registrations and CUT-A-RAMA in Bendigo.

Registrations will be held at the Bridge Hotel, Bridge St Bendigo from 4:30 to 6:00 pm, and the World-Famous **CUT-A-RAMA** from 6:00 pm onwards.

Sunday 2nd June 2024: Bendigo to Mildura.

We will drop into the birthplace of John Flynn on our way to Mildura, where buses will travel the city centre to get you to and from dinner at the Gateway Tavern.

Monday 3rd June 2024: Mildura to Burra.

Only a small town but with quite a lot of accommodation, nowhere will be too far to walk to our dinner in the Burra Town Hall.

Tuesday 4th June 2024: Burra to Arkaroola.

We head cross-country using lots of back roads today as we drive into the Flinders Ranges, where we will spend the night in Arkaroola Village.

Wednesday 5th June 2024: Arkaroola to Innamincka.

Up the aptly named Mt Hopeless Track and onto the Strzelecki Track as we head into the remote north-east of South Australia for dinner at the local pub. This might be our last chance to drive *"The Strez"* before it is sealed......

Thursday 6th June 2024: Innamincka to Wanaaring.

Today we head directly east, through Corner Country to the remote Northern NSW village of Wanaaring on the banks of the Paroo River.

Friday 7th June 2024: Wanaaring to St George.

We head north-east today as we cross the Queensland border, using remote back roads and tracks to our destination of St George on the Balonne River.







Saturday 8th June 2024: St George to Toowoomba.

Our penultimate day of the 2024 Outback Car Trek sees us draw close to the coast, to the Garden City of Toowoomba. Buses will be put on to travel the main motel strip of Ruthven St (the New England Highway) to get us to and from our dinner at the Cathedral Function Centre in Neil St.

Sunday 9th June 2024: Toowoomba to Sea World, Main Beach.

Toowoomba is situated on a majestic escarpment that towers over the Gold Coast Hinterland, and we will wend our way via Tamborine Mountain to our lunch, finish line and final resting place of the 2024 Outback Car Trek, the Sea World Resort at Main Beach. Family & friends are welcome to join us for lunch and dinner at Sea World at cost.

Sea World will hold a block of rooms for our group until 21 December 2023; after that date rooms will be returned to the hotel's pool and will be available to be booked by the general public.


